Program Description

- Shooting for at least 14 consecutive calendar days
- Access to our equipments up to 90% discount (non-member rate)
- Unlimited number of submissions per year
- No financial support

Program Eligibility

- This production support program is open to independent filmmakers at any level of experience
- Students are not eligible (exception for PhD students)
- All applicants must have already been Associate Member for at least one year and be a member when applying
- An unselected project may be submitted again. A project that has previously received support within the program may not be resubmitted
- All applicants must be Canadian citizens or have the permanent resident status and be residents of Quebec

Selection Process

- The selection committee is is an internal committee.
- Results will be given by email within six weeks after the submission. No results will be given over the phone. All decisions are final.

Selection Criterias

- Originality and relevance of the topic
- Artistic value of the project
- Relevance of the needs and realistic expectations

Application Requirements

- CV
- Short biography
- Project proposal including:
 - Cinematic treatment (2 pages max.)
 - Letter of intention (2 pages max.)
 - Synopsis (1 page max.)
 - Description of the main protagonists (if applicable 1 page max)
- List of needed equipment / services (catalog of our equipments)
- Shooting dates
- Budget & Financial structure
- Support material: video (3 minutes max.) previous film ou research sequence for the current project
